- Use bullet points in lieu of talking about {your} experiences in paragraph style.

Part-time, paid, 25 hours per week

- Have more than 1 bullet point per position.
- Within each section, be sure to have roughly the same number of bullet points per entry so that one job does not look significantly more or less important than another.
- Try to edit out "hanging words" like in the previous bullet point to maximize the space and polish up the writing to the best of your ability.

• Bullet point lines should be 1-2 lines maximum – be concise!
