

# **Non-Degree Enrollment**

Enrolling as a non-degree student enables a person to take graduate level social work courses in order to help focus their interests, to test capabilities in a graduate setting, to increase knowledge, or to improve professional skills. Non-degree enrollment is limited to on-campus study and non-degree students are not eligible for financial assistance. Students admitted as non-degree students may not be allowed to register until all degree seeking students have registered. Course registration for any term is dependent upon space availability.

NCFD admission is valid for a single term. NCFD students may request to continue NCFD enrollment in the next term by submitting a request to the School at <a href="mailto:ssw.oss@umich.edu">ssw.oss@umich.edu</a>. Requests must be received at least three weeks prior to the beginning of the term. Requests will be reviewed, including a review of academic progress, and students will be informed of a decision at the earliest date possible.

The School of Social Work offers the following options to those wishing to enroll on a non-degree basis for graduate level social work courses.

# A. Post-MSW Non-Degree Admission Status

Persons who already hold an MSW may enroll for additional graduate level social work credit as non-degree students. You may apply for admission as a non-degree Post-MSW student on-campus/Ann Arbor for any term although course offerings are extremely limited in Spring/Summer.

## **Application Procedures:**

## 1. Application Form

Complete the "Non-Degree/Special Student Application" in its entirety.

#### 2. Application Fee

Mail a check or money order in the amount of \$75.00 (U.S. dollars) for the non-refundable online application fee (PDF submitted via email) or \$150.00 (U.S. dollars) if you must mail in a paper copy of the application. Make payable to the Regents of the University of Michigan.

**NOTE:** If you received your MSW from the University of Michigan, an application fee is not required.

### 3. Statement of Purpose

Attach a one-page statement indicating your interests and reasons for requesting admission as a non-degree student.

# 4. Transcripts

An official transcript from the university/college where you earned your MSW degree must be emailed directly to <a href="mask-transcripts@umich.edu">msw.transcripts@umich.edu</a> via your university/college's official e-transcript service. **NOTE:** If you received your MSW from the University of Michigan, only transcripts from any course work you completed following receipt of your MSW are required.

#### B. UNCLASSIFIED "NON-CANDIDATE FOR DEGREE" (NCFD) ADMISSION STATUS

NCFD is a special admission status appropriate for a student who has earned a bachelor's degree and who wishes to enroll in on-campus/Ann Arbor graduate-level social work courses without entering the degree-granting program. A student may apply for Unclassified NCFD status for any term, although course offerings are extremely limited in Spring/Summer. Admission decisions for NCFD status is based on prior academic credentials and the statement of purpose. Students admitted to NCFD status may not be allowed to register until all degree seeking students have registered. Course registration for any term is dependent upon space availability. A maximum of 19 graduate credit hours earned with a B or better as a non-degree student could be applied toward the Master of Social Work degree if that student were to apply later and be accepted into the MSW Program. However, enrolling in courses as a non-degree student does not guarantee admission to the MSW degree program. Please refer to Criteria for Admission on the School of Social Work website for further information on admission to the MSW Program.

#### 2. **Application Fee**

Mail a check or money order in the amount of \$75.00 (U.S. dollars) for the non-refundable online application fee (PDF submitted via email) or \$150.00 (U.S. dollars) if you must mail in a paper copy of the application. Make payable to the Regents of the University of Michigan.

Note: if you applied to the MSW program for the same term, an NCFD application fee is <u>not</u> required.

# 3. Statement of Purpose

Attach a one-page statement indicating your interests and reasons for requesting admission as a non-degree student.

### 4. Transcripts

An official transcript from <u>each</u> university/college attended must be emailed directly to <u>msw.transcripts@umich.edu</u> via your university/college's official e-transcript service.

5. Email completed application form and all required documents as noted above to ssw.msw.info@umich.edu

(Please note that letters of recommendation are not required.)

# Residency Classification for Tuition Purposes

If you consider yourself a resident of the State of Michigan and you have any of the following non-resident activity, you must <u>file an application</u> with the Residency Classification Office to determine whether you qualify for in-state tuition:

- You live outside the State of Michigan for any purpose, including, but not limited to, education, volunteer activities, travel, or employment;
- You attended or graduated from a college outside the State of Michigan;
- You lived or worked outside the State of Michigan at any time within the last three years;
- You are not a U.S. citizen;
- Your spouse, partner, or parent is in Michigan as a nonresident student, medical resident, fellow or for military assignment or other temporary employment;
- You are 24 years of age or younger and a parent lives outside the State of Michigan;
- You are 24 years of age or younger and attended or graduated from a high school outside the state of Michigan;
- You attended or graduated from an out-of-state high school and have been involved in educational pursuits for the majority of time since high school graduation;
- You attended any University of Michigan campus (Ann Arbor, Dearborn, or Flint) as a non-resident.

Other circumstances also may require you to file an Application for In-State Tuition.

Please note that you may qualify for in-state tuition in any of the following three ways:

- 1. **Residence**. By demonstrating that you are a permanent legal resident of the State of Michigan as defined by the Residency Guidelines;
- 2. **Attendance**. By demonstrating that you attended an accredited Michigan high school and accredited Michigan middle or junior high school; OR
- 3. **Service**. By demonstrating that you or a family member are serving or have served in the U.S. military or Public Health Service.

If your residency status for tuition purposes at the University of Michigan is in question, based on the above information, the School of Social Work encourages you to submit the required Application for In-State Tuition to the Residency Classification Office at the earliest date possible to ensure that a decision can be made in advance of enrollment.
