A proponent of available and opportune help during times of distress and urgency, Michael R. Sosin, the late Emily Klein Gidwitz Professor in the School of Social Service Administration, developed ideas seeking to understand how best to provide and steer aid for improving conditions of those most in need. At the same time, Mike examined and advanced concepts of emergency relief, and advocated for its practicality, fairness, and policies making accessible immediate assistance of the kind typically unavailable from traditional sources and conventions.
