



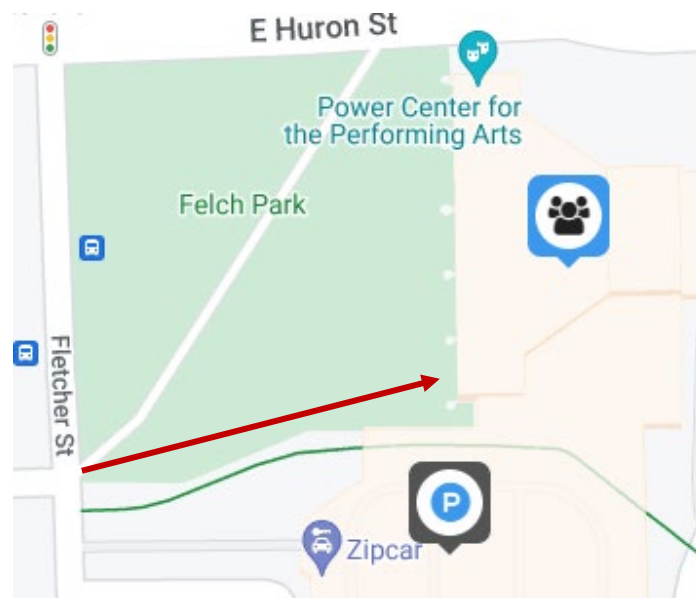
SSW SPRING 2026 COMMENCEMENT -The POWER CENTER- ACCESSIBILITY INFORMATION

Mobility

Graduates and guests with special mobility needs can be dropped off on Fletcher Street near the sidewalk leading up to main entrance to The Power Center. Guests will then be guided to accessible seating or the student robing room.



Real-Time Captioning and Sign Language

A seating area with real-time captioning is available for those with hearing impairments. In addition, a sign language interpreter will be present during the ceremony.

The School of Social Work Commencement will be live-streamed at ssw.umich.edu. Captioning will be available.

Ceremony/Reception Parking

The Thayer street parking structure located at 216 S. Thayer Street will be open to the public for parking at no charge.
