



## **Arthur L. Johnson Scholarship**

### ***I. Purpose***

The Arthur L. Johnson Endowed Scholarship was established by a gift from Richard and Susan Rogel of Avon, Colorado, to honor Arthur Johnson upon his retirement as President of the Detroit Chapter of the NAACP. The Rogels believed the best way to honor Arthur's "love of people, his love of education, and his love of the City of Detroit," was to provide a scholarship to the School of Social Work for a student who is interested in practicing social work in Detroit.

### ***II. Form of Support***

Awards are available for MSW students. A total of \$20,000 will be allocated in 2020-2021.

### ***III. Eligibility***

Eligible applicants are full-time students with an active status in the MSW Program and with an interest in practicing social work in Detroit.

### ***IV. Application Materials***

The following application materials are required:

- 1) Application coversheet
- 2) Two-page statement, double-spaced, describing the applicant's commitment to practicing social work in Detroit
- 3) Resume

### ***V. Review Process***

The School's MSW Financial Aid Committee will evaluate the application materials. The Committee will assess each applicant's commitment to practicing social work in Detroit.

The review and selection for the Arthur L. Johnson Scholarship will take place in December 2020.
