

The Kenneth G. Lutterman Memorial Scholarship

I. Purpose

This Scholarship was established by a gift from Jean Lutterman in memory of her husband, Kenneth Lutterman, who was the Associate Dean of Research at the UM School of Social Work in 2001. The scholarship is awarded to a student interested in research in the treatment of mental health.

II. Form of Support

A \$1,500 award is available for an MSW student.

III. Eligibility

Eligible applicants are full-time or part-time **second year students** with an active status in the MSW Program interested in research in the treatment of mental health.

IV. Application Materials

The following application materials are required:

- 1) Application coversheet
- 2) Two-page statement, double-spaced, describing interest in research in the treatment of mental health
- 3) Resume

V. Review Process

The School's Recruitment Admissions Student Services and Financial Aid (RASSFA) Committee will evaluate the application materials. The Committee will assess the applicant's interest in research in the treatment of mental health and verify that the applicant is a second year student.

The review and selection for the Kenneth G. Lutterman Memorial Scholarship will take place in December 2022.
