



The Rosemary Sarri Scholarship Fund

I. Purpose

The Rosemary Sarri Scholarship fund was established to honor Professor Sarri upon her retirement and provides financial support for students with financial need enrolled at the School of Social Work in the master's degree program who have an interest in social policy or community organization.

II. Form of Support

A \$7,000 award is available to an MSW student.

III. Eligibility

Eligible applicants are full-time students with an active status in the MSW Program who have an interest in community organization or social policy. Preference is given to students with financial need.

IV. Application Materials

The following application materials are required:

- 1) Application coversheet
- 2) One-page statement, double-spaced, describing the ways in which your past, current, and future work has or will contribute to the advancement of community organizing or social policy
- 3) Resume

V. Review Process

The School's Recruitment Admissions Student Services and Financial Aid (RASSFA) Committee will evaluate the application materials. The criteria they will use is the extent to which the student's past work, current MSW studies, and future career goals are likely to contribute to the advancement of community organizing or social policy. Financial need shall be the primary selection criteria. The review and selection for the Rosemary Sarri Scholarship in Community Organization or Social Policy will take place in December 2020.
