Definitions

1. Books & Supplies

Costs are generally unknown until the beginning of the semester. Costs will vary by enrolled courses but include the purchase of books, supplies, and other learning-based materials or subscriptions that are required for the course. Students can reduce costs by comparing prices, buying used books, renting books or using the University Library reserve book system.

2. Room & Board (to cover 4 months each semester)

Costs for housing expenses (rent, utilities, etc.) and meals. The budget allows for students to reside oncampus or off campus. If residing on campus, rent will be charged monthly to your student account bill. If residing off campus, students will be responsible for paying rent directly to a landlord.

3. Transportation

This is an allowance for estimated typical transportation costs. Transportation could be between campus and a place of work, or campus and a residence.

4. Personal & Miscellaneous (to cover 4 months each semester)

Includes expenses such as cell phone bills, clothes, personal hygiene, student health insurance and entertainment. This portion of the budget will vary greatly for each student. Students are encouraged to set a budget, track expenses and stick to a budget.
