PARKING & TRANSPORTATION

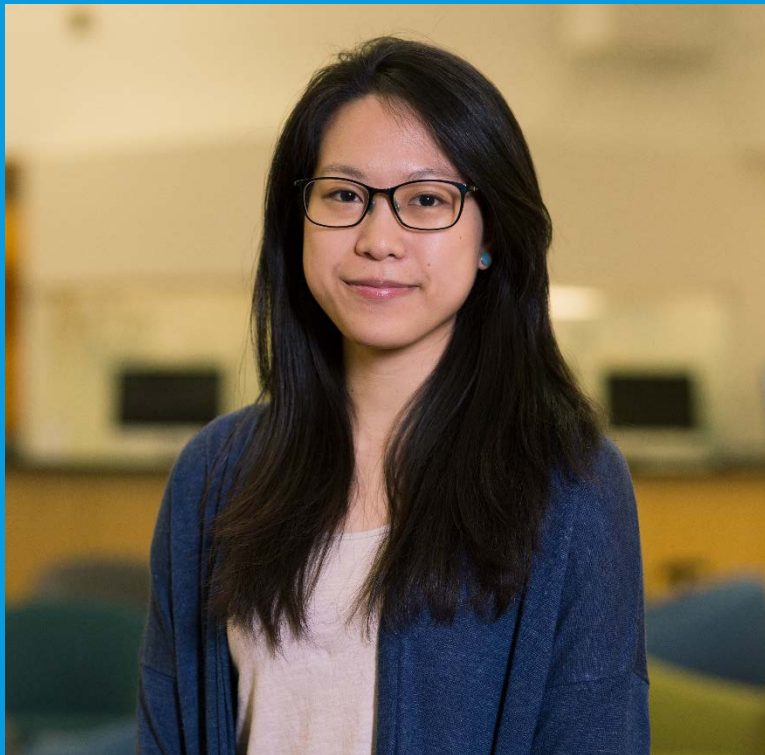
