## Financial Aid Information for Incoming MSW Students Questions Log - August 8, 2022

## **Question Asked**

Is it realistic to hold a GSI position once field starts?

Could you post the link for direct deposit?

When you sign up for a payment plan, is it per semester or for a full year? Do you have to reapply for a payment plan each semester?

When will Finacial Aid Review Statuses be updated to review any aid eligibility or awards?

Do we have to contact Finacial Aid Office first regarding Loans? That page on Wolverine Access is not available yet to look into.

On what date are student loans officially used to pay tuition in our account?

Can a Grad Plus Loan be taking out at any time? Or does it need to be applied for at the beginning of a semester?

How do I process checks made out to myself and the University from an outside scholarship?

If I purchase a student health insurance plan and then in Winter semester obtain a GSI position, will I be refunded for the time that I'd have insurance through the university?

I'm an incoming international student and I already got a position as a GSI. Is there any procedure which I need to proceed in advance?

The positions as research assistants in the school of social work are available for international students? and it's different from GSI?

Can I borrow a loan to cover off campus housing?

I am on studentaid.gov and it is very unclear where we are to go to accept loans. Where can we find more information, please?

Who can help walk us through the financial aid process?

How do we apply for GSI positions?

I moved to MI 12/2021. Would I qualify as a MI resident?

Where can we see if we're missing any documents or parts of the process (e.g. the accept/decline, MPN, or entrance counseling)?

If there is a loan approval but it is not needed right away (money saved to pay), then how is the loan accessed or applied when needed?

Would the SSW grants/scholarships with no separate application already be applied to our account if we recieved them?

## **Answer Given**

It can be tricky, but some students have been able to manage it. Often when you are a GSI you need to attend the undergraduate lecture in addition to running discussion secstions. This would be something to explore when applying for the position. Some positions are smaller appointments and require less work.

You can access Grad Plus loans during the semester as long as the semester is not over. It takes some time to apply and get processed so you'll want to make sure to give yourself ample time.

Congratulations! You should let the Office of Student Services know if you have any grant/scholarship aid from the School of Social Work. We need to remove your aid so your GSI pays the entire tuition. Sometimes we can make our aid refundable so you can use it for living expenses. Email us at ssw.msw.info@umich.edu

Yes, GSSRA positions are available to MSW students, but are quite rare. They are often reserved for PhD students. International students can hold GSSRA, GSI, or GSSA positions.

Yes, you can use a Direct Loan or Grad Plus Loan to pay for campus or off-campus housing.

Loans need to be accepted in your Wolverine Access account.,Be sure to also send in your form to accept school of social work grant/scholarship aid. It was with the financial aid offer letter.

You can look at your financial aid information in your Wolverine Access account. I also recommend reaching out to the Office of Financial Aid 734-763-6600 to check on this.

All aid (grants, scholarships, loans) will first go toward paying your tuition. If you have any excess money after tuition/fees are paid they will be refunded to you and you could use it to pay expenses for the future.
