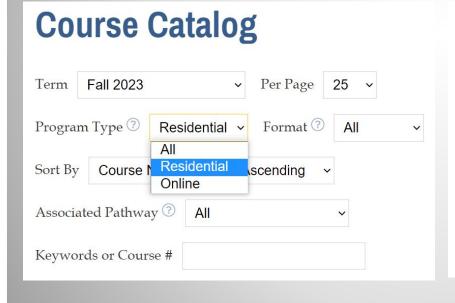

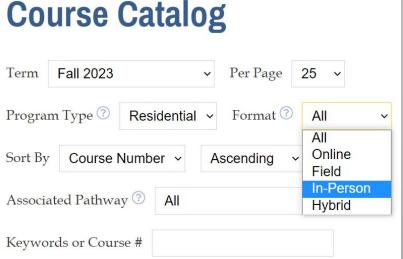

  - CBI/NCS given course permission. Others may petition.



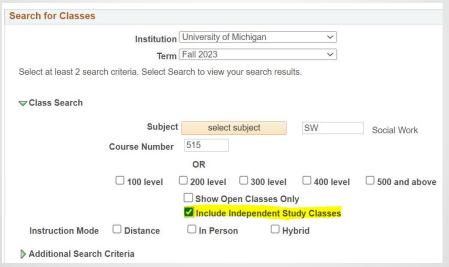
# Registering for Courses

- Wolverine Access
- Step by step details:

- Must load classes in your backpack <u>prior</u> to your registration time
- Important to register for classes as close to registration time as possible.



### Searching for Courses – Wolverine Access

- Wolverine Access
- If registering for 515 or 691 click "include independent study classes."



- Field placement confirmed: Choose section with field faculty who placed you
- Field placement not confirmed: Choose section 888



# Closed Courses or Dept. Consent Required

- Course Enrollment Petition
- Classes capped early to allow for greatest need
- Submit petitions as soon as possible following your registration time. Submit ALL needed petitions.
- Only petition for one section of a particular class. Mention other sections that will work.
- Decisions will be made on rolling basis. Watch email for an email response



# Tips for Completing Enrollment Petition Form

- Be specific. Provide all of the details necessary to explain why you MUST be considered for the specific course and specific section in the narrative box.
- Be flexible. If more than one section could work for you, petition for your preference, but include in your narrative other options that could work.
- Know that we do not give preference based on preferred instructors. If there are spots available, we might allow you into a closed course based on preference for a certain instructor, but other needs are given priority.
- Course instructors do not have authorization to grant permission for students to enter a closed course. Please do not email them asking for permission.



# **Exemptions**

- Exemption request form
- Based on coursework completed in past six years with "B" or better grades
- Exemptions do not reduce credit hour requirements, but do allow for students to replace the foundation course with an elective course
- Advanced standing students <u>do not</u> need to pursue exemptions from SW 506, SW 507, SW 508, SW 509, and SW 515. Can apply for SW 505.
- MasterTrack/UM Sociology/UM Dearborn <u>do not</u> need to pursue exemptions from SW 505, SW 506, SW 507, SW 508 or SW 509
- Exemption decisions are e-mailed to your umich.edu e-mail address

- More courses in your pathway
- Secondary Pathway (review course planning worksheet)
- School Social Worker Specialization
- Courses in another pathway
- Mini courses (One-credit courses)
- Doctoral Courses (800 level)
- Independent Studies (up to 12 credits, 6 credits/term)
- Courses Outside SSW:

  - or search Wolverine Access
- Additional Field Instruction



### **Substitutions**

- Substitution review is a student-initiated and online process:
  - https://ssw.umich.edu/assets/course-substitution/
- Students may substitute a SSW course or a graduate course in another UM department to meet a program requirement. Must be approved by advisor and MSW Program Director
- A substitution for a foundation course would typically require completing an advanced pathway course that covered content on the foundation course topic
- Substitutions can be a good option for student with extensive work experience related to a required course
