

## **Doctoral Scholarship for Underrepresented Students**

2023-2024

#### I. Purpose and Eligibility

This award is available to students in the Joint Doctoral Program. This fund provides support to doctoral students who come from an educational, cultural, or geographic background that is underrepresented in graduate study at the University of Michigan and who demonstrate unmet financial need due to a life crisis or some other foreseeable circumstance. Students must meet one or more of the following criteria. Students may receive support from this fund in the amount of \$500 per year per student. One student this year may receive support.

- Come from an educational, cultural or geographic background that is underrepresented in graduate study in their discipline in the United States or at the University of Michigan;
- Has experienced financial hardship as a result of family economic circumstances;
- Are first-generation U.S. citizens or are the first generation in their families to graduate from a fouryear college.

**Note:** students will not be eligible for this award if they received a Meyer, Curtis or Kellogg Scholarship within the same year. In addition, students are not eligible to receive the same award more than once during their time in the Joint Doc Program. You must be in good standing to apply for this award.

#### II. Form of Support

For 2022-2023, a \$500 award will be made to a Doctoral student in the form of stipend support.
