



Anti-Racism Fund Student Organization Grant Application: Large Grant Guidelines

The School of Social Work (SSW) invites grant applications from SSW Sponsored Student Organizations (SSO) and Voluntary Student Organizations (VSO) who are registered with the SSW Office of Student Services.

Anti-racism grants are available to support student organization activities and projects by student groups for anti-racism work, with a specific focus on confronting anti-Blackness, racism against Indigenous peoples, and confronting white supremacy. The goal is to inclusively support the work of student groups seeking to confront racism to the greatest degree possible. Such funding could be for projects, events, services, programming, or partnerships with external organizations.

Grant Guidelines
Max Request Amount: \$2,000
Application will be taken on a rolling basis until funds are expended
Complete applications must include budget proposal and an itemized budget.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Funds must be used for projects, activities and events that are educational in nature and connect directly to the SSW Mission and Strategic Plan.Regular student organization meetings will not be considered for sponsorshipStudent organizations must have an active University account. Funds will be provided via this account.Student organizations may not use University funds to purchase alcohol or tobacco products.
