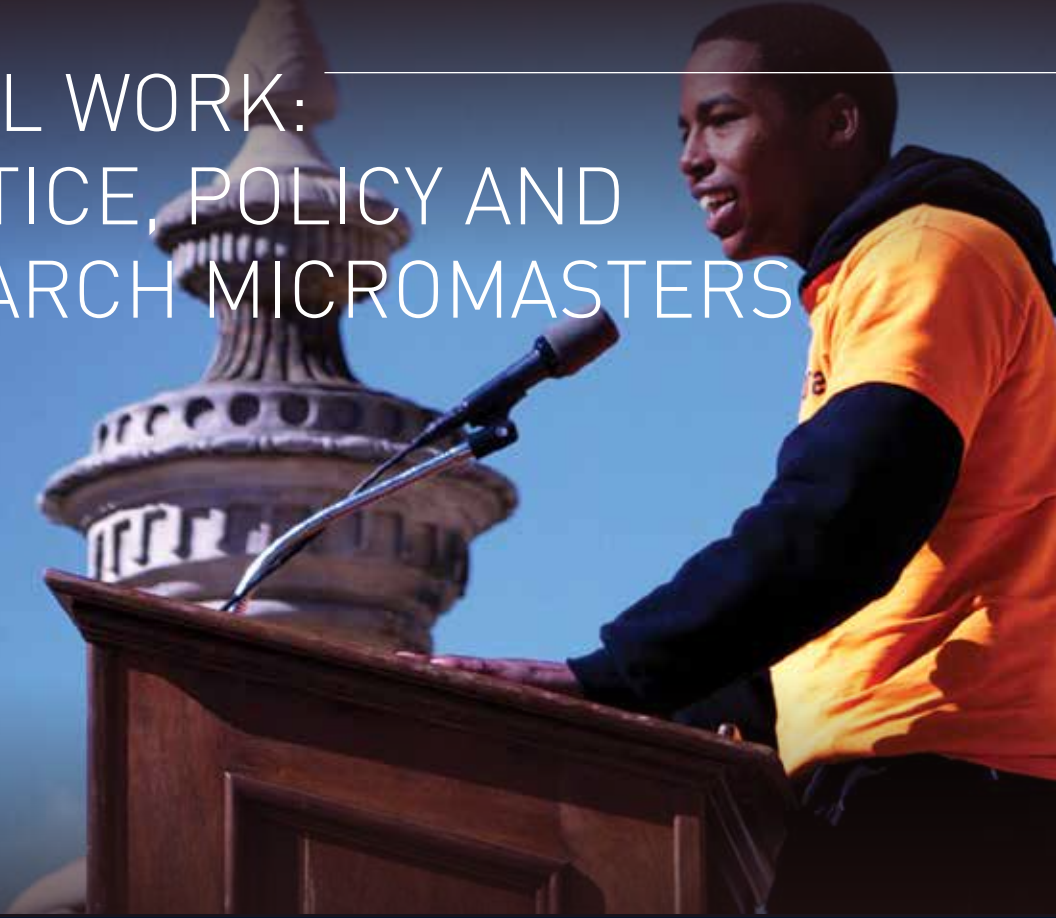


SOCIAL WORK: PRACTICE, POLICY AND RESEARCH MICROMASTERS
